Located on Lake George road between Drahner and Predmore roads, the Addison-Oaks Christmas tree farm was started in 1988 by owners Frank and Cathy Rimi. Blessed with sandy loam soil, several varieties of



Christmas trees are grown on the 20-acre farm. The types of Christmas trees range from firs (Fraser, Concolor, Douglas, and Arizona Corkbark) to spruces (Norway, Black Hills, Colorado Blue, and White).

"Our eco-friendly farm management ensures that your organically grown tree has never been sprayed with harmful pesticides or chemical colorant," said Frank. Additionally, trees are hand-trimmed and grass is mowed for the shoppers convenience.

The Rimi's also offer many different holiday decorations, including beautiful handmade wreaths and garland, grave blankets, tree stands, disposal bags, and even holiday lights! There is also a warm-up area stocked with donuts, hot drinks, and candy canes for the kids.

to be safe while cutting down your tree! Bow saws and wagon carts are provided for those ready to track down their perfect tree. And when you have found your tree, it is mechanically cleaned and twine is also provided to secure the tree to your vehicle.
